



Junk Removal Checklist

Wanting your junk removed?
Here's what you need first,



Research good junk removal companies. If you already have Load of Rubbish on your list you're off to a good start!



Identify items you want to be removed. Load of Rubbish can take almost anything; from home appliances, furniture, computers, construction materials to yard waste, even pianos and hot tubs!

Take pictures of the items you want to be removed. You might want to document this so you can send it to us for easier reference and quoting. Pictures can be emailed or sent by text, we will respond promptly with a quote.
